



PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

What is proposed?

This 95-year-old bridge, the existing bridge on SR 38/US 84 over the Satilla River, is proposed to be replaced.

How will I be affected?

This boat access, the US 84 Landing on the Satilla River Water Trail, would be closed during construction of the proposed project.

How long will this last?

This boat access would be closed for approximately 4 years beginning in the Spring of 2021 and lasting until the Spring of 2025.

Where can I access the river?

- Upstream at the Jamestown Landing
 - Take US 84 west to Waycross
 - Turn right on US 1 (Business)/Ossie Davis Parkway
 - Veer right on Jamestown Landing Road
 - Stay on Jamestown Landing Road until you reach the Satilla River
- Downstream at the GA 121 Landing
 - Take US 84 east to Blackshear
 - Turn right on SR 15/121
 - Stay on SR 15/121 until you reach the Satilla River
