



Part-time Internship
GIS and Outdoor Recreation

The Satilla Riverkeeper is a member supported, 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to protecting, restoring and educating about the beautiful and unique Satilla River. The Satilla River is a blackwater coastal river located in Southeast Georgia, with the office stationed in Nahunta, GA (Brantley County). We advocate for the right to swimmable, fishable, and drinkable waters for all to enjoy.

Satilla Riverkeeper is seeking a motivated and skilled intern to assist the Executive Director/Riverkeeper in evaluating the recreational use opportunities available on the Satilla River and the larger coastal region. The intern will assist in gathering and analyzing GIS data, as well as creating interactive web-based maps to communicate the availability of recreation access to the public. The intern will also assist with measuring recreational use at public access points along the Satilla River Water Trail. The intern will also have the opportunity to engage in other projects as time and interest allows.

This opportunity will be both demanding and rewarding. The intern will obtain real-world experience in an environmental nonprofit. We seek an individual with a sincere interest in learning about nonprofit work and/or interest in promoting awareness of outdoor recreation and ecotourism on the Satilla River and issues facing the river.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

GIS Analysis

- Collect and compile publicly available data to quantify public access to recreation opportunities
- Create maps and reports to effectively communicate this information

Recreational Use Surveys

- Assist in creating survey to measure recreational use at public access points
- Conduct surveys in the field
- Analyze and effectively communicate survey data.

Preferred Qualifications:

- **Required:** GIS skills, and experience. Must have access to GIS software.
- Independent worker, who is self-motivated, detail-oriented, and organized.
- Excellent written and oral communications skills, ability to communicate effectively with people of a wide range of ages and backgrounds.
- Takes initiative without being asked, predicts and prevents problems, meets deadlines.
- Team-player willing to contribute to a positive, yet professional, working environment in a mission-driven organization.
- Knowledge of outdoor recreation, ecotourism, watershed concepts, environmental policy, natural history, or ecology of southeast Georgia, or interest and ability to learn.

Compensation: This is an **unpaid internship**. Course credit available, if facilitated by student. Some professional development opportunities may be available. Reimbursement for work related expenses, as approved by Executive Director. Telework options available.

Time Commitment: About 10-20 hours a week, flexible hours, requiring some work on evenings and weekends. Schedule to be set/approved by Executive Director. Internship will start in May 2019, and end in August 2019. There may be an opportunity to extend the internship beyond August.
